Materials Needed:

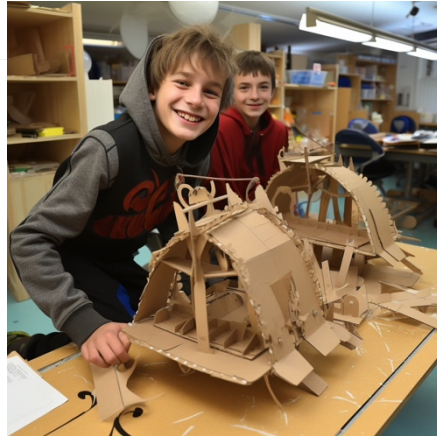
Craft sticks
